About our FFC Program

St. Cornelius Parish is pleased to offer a Faith Formation for Children program to assist families in the religious education of their children. The program is open to young parishioner in grades 1-8 who attend public, or non-Catholic private schools.

How do I register?

Families who wish to enroll their child(ren) in the Faith Formation program can access the registration form at www.saintcornelius.org under the "Faith Formation for Children" tab. Families asked to print a completed registration form and return it to the Parish Life Center along with the registration fee. If a child was baptized at a church other than St. Cornelius, a copy of the child's baptismal certificate should accompany the registration form.

When are classes held?

Faith Formation classes are held twice a week; on Tuesday afternoons from 4:45-6:00pm, and on Wednesday evenings from 6:00-7:15pm. Students can attend either session. Classes begin in early to mid-September and generally run through thru May of the following year.

Do we get to pick which day/time we want?

All families can select their preferred day/time. All preferences will be honored when possible.

What is expected of the parents/guardians?

The Faith Formation program exists to support parents/guardians in their primary role as teachers of the faith. It is expected that families encourage and support the student's learning, assist with homework and assignments, and model prayer and participation in the Sacramental life of the parish community. Families are also asked to assist as volunteers in the Faith Formation program during the course of the year.
